

RESOLUTION 00 03 ⁹23 -327

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Water District 125, King County, Washington, increasing the charge of locking meters and increasing the after hour charge and repealing prior Resolution 80 09 10 -69 and establishing a time after which locked meters will not be unlocked.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that operating costs associated with shutting off meters have increased, necessitating a raise in the fees, there; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish a time after which meters will be unlocked; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District 125, King County, Washington, as follows:

Section One: Locking meters - Unlocking meters.

The customer shall be charged \$35.00 for locking a meter for nonpayment, except that the charge shall be \$50.00 if done after 4:30 PM and before 8:00 PM. There will be no charge for unlocking the meter. Resolution 80 09 10 -69 Section One is hereby amended to reflect these increased fees.

Section Two: Time Line Limit to Unlock Meters

Meters will not be unlocked between the hours of 8:00 PM and 8:00 AM.
