RESOLUTION NO. 03 01 09 353

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 125 REVISING AND AMENDING CERTAIN DISTRICT ADMINISTRATIVE FEES AND CHARGES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 125 (“District”) finds it necessary to revise certain administrative fees and charges relating to the provision of, billing for and shut-off of water service; and

WHEREAS, the District Board of Commissioners now desires to revise and update the referenced charges and fees and having considered the recommendation of District staff; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No 125, King County, Washington that the following administrative fees and charges are hereby revised and amended and shall be imposed and collected by the District:


1. Returned Check Fee: \$25.00
2. Delinquent Account Meter Lock Charge: \$35.00
3. Delinquent Account After Hours Meter Unlock Charge: \$90.00 to be assessed after the close of District business (4:30 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.) Monday through Friday; an after hours charge will be assessed on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.; provided there shall be no meter unlocks performed after 8:00 p.m. on any day; an unlock charge is limited to unlocking a meter. No after hours charge will be assessed for general customer service as determined by the District such as shutting off water service for leaks and service line installations.
4. System Tampering Charge: A charge of \$100 shall be imposed for tampering with a meter, service or the District’s water system as that term is defined by RCW 80.28.240(1) and the District in addition to all other fees, charges and penalties imposed by the District in such situations.
5. Occupant Billing Fee: a fee of \$1.00 per billing which is mailed to the occupant of a dwelling unit receiving water service from the District where the occupant is not the owner of the dwelling unit/property receiving water service.


The fees and charges adopted herein shall modify, amend and supersede all existing District resolutions, policies and procedures which are inconsistent herewith.

This resolution and the fees and charges set forth herein shall be effective on the date set forth below.
