RESOLUTION NO. 03 06 25 -361

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 125 ESTABLISHING A REVISED WATER GENERAL FACILITY CONNECTION CHARGE, AND SUPERCEDING RESOLUTION NUMBER 93-11-10-277.

WHEREAS, RCW 57.08.005(10) authorizes King County Water District No. 125 ("District") to charge property owners seeking connection to the District's water system, as a condition to granting the right to so connect, in addition to the cost of the connection, such reasonable connection charges as the District Board of Commissioners shall determine to be proper in order that those property owners shall bear their equitable share of the cost of the water system; and

WHEREAS, the District previously adopted a water general facility connection charge ("GFC") pursuant to Resolution No. 93-11-10-277 of \$720 per Residential Equivalent ("RE") applicable to property owners seeking connection to the District's water system; and

WHEREAS, the District contracted with Penhallegon Associates Consulting Engineers, Inc. ("PACE") to review and update the GFC, and PACE prepared a written report recommending that the GFC be revised to \$2,000 per RE based on a ¾ inch or smaller water meter; and

WHEREAS, the District held a public hearing on the proposed revision of the District's water GFC on June 25, 2003 pursuant to notice of such hearing published in the Seattle Daily Journal of Commerce on June 13, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the District Board of Commissioners now desires to update and revise the GFC and having considered the recommendation of PACE and the public comments related to the proposed revision of such charge; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 125 as follows:

1. Water General Facility Connection Charge. A GFC of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) per RE based on a ¾ inch and smaller meter is hereby adopted and shall be assessed against owners of real property seeking connection to or increased service (such as a new service or change in service) from the District's water system.

GFC's for RE's for water meters larger than 3/4 inch shall be determined and assessed as follows:

<u>Meter Size</u>	<u>Number of REs</u>
3/4" meter and smaller	1
1" meter	2
1 1/2" meter	5
2" meter	8
3" meter	22
4" meter	31
6" meter	66
8" meter	112
10" meter	169
12" meter	238

2. Time of Payment. GFC(s) shall be due and payable to the District at the time of meter application for water service unless District resolution or policy provides otherwise.
3. Periodic Update. The GFC referenced herein shall be reviewed by the District periodically and may be adjusted as necessary to include the actual cost to construct facilities planned for construction within the next ten years as contained in the District's comprehensive plan.
4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective on the 26th day of June, 2003.
5. Amendment. All prior and existing District resolutions, policies and procedures, including Resolution No. 93-05-12-274 are hereby modified, amended and superceded to be in accordance with the GFC established herein.
