As of this date all vouchers numbered 12454 - 12499 in the total amount of \$41,023.61 were approved for payment.

There was an IWG meeting last night and a legal review meeting scheduled April 7, 1997.

A copy of IWG's latest assessment (4) in the amount \$2,096 was not approved for payment. This assessment was dated March 3, 1997.

There was a Joint Reservoir Progress Report. Skyway is still in the process of acquiring easements for the project. Negotiations progress has been made in regards to two of the outstanding easements. The third and final is pending reply to the District's latest offer. They have requested and received a waiver from King County regarding their barrier free and fuel storage requirements for the pump station and emergency generator. Their waiver request for sprinkler requirements was denied. They have made a second appeal in regards to the waiver of the sprinkler requirement and are awaiting a final decision. The off site construction project manual is now the process of being prepared. The on site construction manual will be prepared once all the requirements/approvals are confirmed.
