**RESOLUTION NO. 11-14-07-415**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 125 ESTABLISHING A STANDBY FIRE PROTECTION CHARGE FOR TWO INCH WATER METERS AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 06-04-26-396.

**WHEREAS**, RCW 57.08.081 authorizes King County Water District No. 125 ("District") to fix rates and charges for providing water service, such rates and charges to be fixed as deemed necessary by the District Board of Commissioners so that uniform charges will be made for the same class of customer or service and facility; and

**WHEREAS**, RCW 57.08.081 authorizes the District Board of Commissioners in classifying customers to consider in its discretion several factors including the difference in cost to various customers; the location of the various customers within and without the District; the difference in cost of maintenance, operation, repair and replacement of the various parts of the system; the different character of the service provided to various customers; the quantity and quality of the service and facility furnished; the time of its use; the achievement of water conservation goals and the discouragement of wasteful practices; and any other matters which present a reasonable difference as a ground for distinction in the establishment of water service rates and charges; and

**WHEREAS**, the District Board of Commissioners previously established water service rates for all customer classifications, including standby fire protection charges, by the adoption of Resolution No. 06-04-26-396 on April 26, 2006, and

**WHEREAS**, District staff and PACE Engineers ("Consultant") now recommend that the District adopt and impose a standby fire protection charge for District customers with a separate two (2) inch water meter for fire protection; now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 125 as follows:

1. A bi-monthly charge of Seven Dollars (\$7.00) is hereby approved and adopted and all District customers with a separate two (2) inch water meter for fire protection shall pay such charge, together with all other applicable rates and charges for water service provided to such customers in accordance with the District's billing and collection resolutions, policies and procedures.
2. All District resolutions, policies and procedures, including Resolution No. 06-04-26-396 is hereby modified and amended to be in accordance with this resolution effective the date set forth below.
