COMMISSIONERS:

Minutes of the August 12, 1992 meeting were approved as written.

Vouchers audited and certified by the auditing officer as required by R.C.W. 42.040.080 and those expense reimbursement claims certified by R.C.W. 42.040.090 have been made available to the Board. As of this date, all vouchers numbered 1038 in the total amount of \$1,814.39 and vouchers numbered 9326 - 9379 in the total amount of \$86,722.23 were approved for payment.

ENGINEER:

Mr. Penhallegon reported on the following projects:

Dondero Motel Extension, at South 146th and Pacific Highway South: System has been installed and complete. The paving restoration has been done and is acceptable to the City of Tukwila. Developer has been informed to get his certifications and bill of sale forms submitted for acceptance by the District.

Boeing Spares Watermain Relocate: The Watermain improvements are complete. South 142nd Street is currently being lowered. Final inspection of the water system will be performed upon completion of the street improvements.

Benny Woyvodich Developers Extension at South 140th Street and Military:

The entire watermain is in place. The initial purity test failed requiring reflushing and a second test which passed. Connection to the existing system will be made on Friday, September 11, 1992.

ATTORNEY:

The assumption of a Water District in more than one city was discussed.

SUPERINTENDENT:

Mr. Austin continued the water emergency until October 15, 1992.

By motion duly made, seconded and approved, the meeting was adjourned.
