RESOLUTION NO. 16-01-27-476

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 125, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, REVISING WATER METER INSTALLATION AND METER DROP CHARGES.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 125 ("District") charges property owners seeking to connect real property to the District's water system a water meter installation charge to recover the cost of materials, paving, labor, equipment, permitting and administration incurred to process such requests and install such water service lines and meters ("Water Meter Installation Charge"); and

WHEREAS, the District has charged the owners of real property located within the City of Tukwila ("Tukwila") water meter installation charges that are higher than other jurisdictions such as the Cities of Seatac and Burien, and in King County due to Tukwila's imposition of a pavement mitigation fee ("Mitigation Fee") for water service installations; and

WHEREAS, Tukwila by ordinance now requires that all new buildings over five hundred (500) square feet be provided with sprinkler systems for fire suppression purposes, and Tukwila may require certain existing buildings be provided with sprinkler systems for fire suppression purposes when such buildings are renovated or otherwise undergo a change use as determined by Tukwila; and

WHEREAS, District staff and the District's consulting engineers have recommended the District increase its water service installation and meter drop fees and charges to fully recover the cost of such services; and

WHEREAS, the District is authorized to recover such water service installation and meter drop fees and charges pursuant to Chapter 57.08 RCW; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the King County Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, as follows:

1. Water Meter Installation Charges:

The following water meter installation charges shall be paid to the District by parties seeking to connect real property to the District's water system based on customer meter size and jurisdiction in which the meter is installed as follows:

A. Existing Water Service Upgrade in the City of Tukwila

B. Existing Water Service Upgrade in the City of SeaTac and Burien and in Unincorporated King County:

- 2. <u>Effective Date</u>: The revised water meter installation charges set forth in this resolution shall be effective and imposed as of October 14, 2015.
- 3. <u>Amendment</u>: District Resolution No. 12-09-26-450 and all other District resolutions, policies and procedures are hereby modified, amended and superseded to be in accordance with the provisions of this resolution.
