

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, adjusting the compensation rate for the district's general counsel and amending Resolution No. 78 08 09 - 20.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has accepted its general counsel's request for an increase in rate of compensation for legal services; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, as follows:

Resolution No. 78 08 09 - 20, Section Two, is amended to read as follows:

Compensation of the general counsel shall be at \$75.00 per hour plus costs, billable and payable monthly.

In all other respects, resolution No. 78 08 09 - 20 remains in full force and effect.

Resolution No. 79 04 11 - 39 is hereby superceded by this Resolution.
