

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, increasing the charge for shutting off meters (amending Resolution No. 79 01 10 - 32) and establishing a fee for returned checks.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that operating costs associated with shutting off meters have increased, necessitating a raise in the fees therefor; and

WHEREAS, operating costs associated with handling checks returned by the district's bank necessitate charging a fee therefor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, as follows:

Section One: Shut-off Fees -- Reopening of Meters. The customer shall be charged \$10.00 for shutting off of a meter, except that the charge shall be \$20.00 if done outside of regular operating hours of the district. There shall be no charge for reopening of a meter. Resolution No. 79 01 10 - 32 is hereby amended to reflect these increased fees.

Section Two: Returned Check Fee. The district shall charge a fee of \$5.00 to the customer for all checks returned by the district's bank as unpaid for any reason.
