

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, setting forth the connection charge to be assessed property owners seeking to connect to the district's water supply system.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has found that an equitable sharing of the costs of development of the water district's system will be accomplished by a late-comer's connection charge as set forth below and as authorized by Wash. Law Ch. 108, §1 (R.C.W. 57.08.010); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners, Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, that property owners seeking to connect to the district's water supply system, as a condition to approving such connection and in addition to the cost of such connection, shall pay a late-comer's connection charge of \$3.00 per front foot of the owner's property.
