

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, relating to Conditions and Standards for Constructing Extensions to the Water System, setting engineering fees therefor and amending Resolution Nos. 78 10 11 - 24 and 80 07 09 - 66.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has been advised by the district's consulting engineers regarding engineering costs, and the board finds that engineering fees for developer extension engineering services need to be revised in order to avoid economic loss by the consulting engineers in providing necessary services in developer extensions; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington as follows:

Section One: Engineering fees for services performed by the district's consulting engineers shall be imposed and collected as follows:

(a) Engineering services performed by Water District Engineers (Form A of Conditions and Standards)

(1) For lines 800 lineal feet or less: the current hourly rate of the district engineers plus the district engineers' out-of-pocket costs, not to exceed a total of \$2,000 plus out-of-pocket costs.

(2) For lines greater than 800 lineal feet and up to and including 1600 lineal feet: \$2.50 per lineal foot plus the district engineers' out-of-pocket costs.


1600 lineal feet: \$2.00 per lineal
foot plus the district engineers'
out-of-pocket costs.

(b) Engineer services performed by
the Developer
(Form B of Conditions and Standards)


(1) For services listed in
paragraph 3 of Form B, Application
for Permission to Construct Extensions
to Distribution System, etc.: the
district engineers' current hourly
rate with a \$1,000 cash deposit
required in advance of approval of
the application.

Section Two: Resolution numbers 78 10 11 - 24
and 80 07 09 - 66, relating to Conditions and
Standards for Constructing Extensions to the Water
System are each hereby amended to reflect the
engineering fee structure set forth in Section One
above.




