

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, establishing new water rates for district customers and repealing prior rate resolution No. 79 01 10 - 31.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has received notice of raises in wholesale water and electric (street light) rates from the Seattle Water Department (37% raise) and Seattle City Light (46% raise); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has studied current and projected figures for operations costs, maintenance needs and anticipated revenue in the district; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that additional revenue must be generated from water service to the district's customers in order to maintain fiscal responsibility; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, as follows:

Section One. Effective Date/Street Light Component.

(a) The customer rates set forth in Section Two of this Resolution shall be effective with the customer billings for January, 1981.

(b) The rates in this Resolution are designed to provide for street light costs at the rate of \$2.00 per customer per month.

Section Two. Water Service Charges. Customers of Water District No. 125 shall be charged for water service as follows:

(a) Single Family Residential Rate:
meter size of not more than one inch; base rate of \$5.00 per month, plus 40 cents per hundred cubic feet of water consumed.

(b) Multiple Residential, Commercial,

Industrial and Municipal Rate:

plus, in multiple unit customers, a charge of \$3.50 per month for each additional unit.

(c) Wholesale Rate to Other Water

Districts: Base Rate as in Sub-section (b) based on meter size, plus a Consumption Charge of 30 cents per hundred cubic feet of water transferred through the meter.

Section Three. Definitions.

(a) "Single family residence" shall mean an owned residence designed or used for residential occupancy by a single residential unit. Provided, however, that condominium residences shall be billed as multiple residential customers.

(b) "Unit" shall mean a single family residential quarters, a separate commercial building, a trailer located on a residential lot and connected for domestic water service, and any individually rentable apartment, office, place of business, trailer court stall or mobile home lot.

Section Four. Repealer. The district's prior rate resolution, No. 79 01 10 - 31, is repealed.
