

A RESOLUTION DECLARING MISCELLANEOUS EQUIP-  
MENT AS SURPLUS PROPERTY OF THE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS Water District No. 125 has assorted equipment in its possession for which it has no use, and

WHEREAS Water District No. 125 under the terms of RCW 57.08.015 may sell surplus goods by private sale where the value of such property does not exceed two-hundred and fifty dollars,

NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Board of Commissioners unanimously declare that the property listed below is not and will not be needed for district purposes; 1 IBM typewriter, 1 Olivetti typewriter, 1 Royal typewriter, 1 Adler calculator, 1 Addressograph cabinet, 2 Burroughs billing machines, 1 Olivetti billing machine and 1 Addressograph printer, and 1 Underwood adding machine.

2. That the Board of Commissioners recognize that the equipment may have little or no commercial value.

3. That the Office Manager of Water District No. 125 is authorized by the Board of Commissioners to negotiate the sale of the equipment privately.

4. In the event the District is unable to sell the equipment and at least two junk dealers are unwilling to pay any amount for the junk designated as surplus, the Superintendent is authorized to remove it to the dump and pay any costs for such.
