

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, amending prior resolutions (80 12 10 - 75 and 81 10 14 - 85) and establishing a new wholesale rate for sale of water to municipalities and special service districts.

WHEREAS, new water rates charged by the City of Seattle to Water District No. 125 under the Water Purveyor Contract of 1981 (approved by the district under Resolution No. 82 01 12 - 91) establish higher rates for "new water," that is water obtained in volumes in excess of an "old water" base period of 1979-80-81; thus causing current and future wholesale purchase of water by other municipalities and special service districts to result in this district paying higher rates to the City of Seattle; and

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners finds it necessary to establish a new rate for such wholesale transfers in order to maintain fiscal responsibility in furnishing such water; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, as follows:

1. Resolution No. 80 12 10 - 75, subsection 2(c) is amended to read as follows:

(c) Wholesale Rate to Other Water Districts:

Base Rate as in Sub-section (b) based on meter size, plus a Consumption Charge of 60 cents per hundred cubic feet of water transferred through the meter.

2. Resolution No. 81 10 14 - 85, which added a "Section Five" to the aforementioned Resolution No. 80 12 10 - 75 is amended to read as follows:

Section Five. Sewer Districts drawing water directly from hydrants shall be charged, in addition to 60 cents per hundred cubic feet for water so drawn, \$ 10 per i covering such water consum
