

A resolution of the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, establishing a ten percent penalty for late payment of water charges and amending Resolution No. 80 12 10 - 75

WHEREAS, state law (R.C.W. 57.08.080) requires that the commissioners enforce water rates by addition of penalties of not more than ten percent of the charges due in case of failure to pay charges at times fixed by resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington as follows:

Resolution No. 80 12 10 - 75, the current water rate resolution of this district (as amended by Resolution Nos. 81 10 14 - 85 and 84 06 06 - 124) is hereby amended by adding thereto "Section Six" as follows:

Section Six. Bills for water supplied shall become delinquent after ~~thirty~~ days and, if the bills remain unpaid after ~~ninety~~ days following the date of the bill, a one-time penalty of ten percent shall be assessed and added to the bill.
