BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, as follows:



5. 1024 South 156th Street



SERVICE AREA BOUNDARY AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN
WATER DISTRICT NO. 125 AND WATER DISTRICT NO. 20,
KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 16th day of August, 1988, by and between Water District No. 125, a municipal corporation located in King County, Washington, hereinafter referred to as "District 125" and Water District No. 20, a municipal corporation located in King County, Washington, hereinafter referred to as "District 20".

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, that it is the intent of the Districts executing this Agreement to provide a means for allocating water service for certain properties within District 125, which properties are commonly known as:

1. 1040 South 156th Way
2. 1014 South 156th Street
3. 1016 South 156th Street
4. 1020 South 156th Street
5. 1024 South 156th Street

in order to ensure the maximum efficient use of existing and future facilities so as to provide water service to rate payers at the most reasonable cost and to provide for coordination of the orderly and efficient distribution of water service within the respective Districts; and

WHEREAS, the signatory Districts believe that the listed locations can most efficiently be served by District 20.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, it is hereby agreed that District 20 shall henceforth assume responsibility for water service and include

within its service area the residential premises listed above and District 125 shall henceforth remove said Premises from its services area pursuant to the authority of RCW 57.08.045.
