

RESOLUTION NO. 90 10 10-237

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, providing a ten percent penalty on delinquent customer bills, amending Resolution No. 89 03 28-214 and repealing Resolution No. 85 02 12-159.

WHEREAS, state law (R.C.W. 57.08.080) requires that the commissioners enforce collection of charges for water supplied by addition of penalties of not more than ten percent of the charges due in case of failure to pay charges at times fixed by resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, as follows:

Resolution No. 89 03 28-214 is hereby amended to add the following:


Section Five. Penalty for Delinquent Bills.

Bills for water supplied shall be dated the 21st day of the month of the bill; and the bill shall become delinquent if not paid within thirty days of the date of the bill. If the bill remains unpaid forty-five days after the date of the bill, a one-time penalty of ten percent shall be assessed and added to the bill. *This penalty provision becomes effective January 1, 1991.*

Resolution No. 85 02 12-159 is repealed.
