A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, providing for payment to retiring employees for accumulated sick leave and amending Resolution 78 03 08 - 11.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, after comparing personnel policies of other, similar water and sewer districts, has determined that the current prohibition against payment of accumulated sick leave to terminating employees should be reconsidered with respect to employees who are retiring; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that such compensation should be paid to retiring employees; NOW, THEREFORE:


BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington as follows:

1. The sick Leave provision of Resolution No. 78 03 08 - 11 (page 4) is amended, effective January 1, 1992, to provide that, upon retirement (as defined by the Washington State Public Employees Retirement System, R.C.W. 41.40.010(22)), the employee shall be paid for accumulated sick leave.
2. The existing prohibition against benefits for accumulated sick leave under other forms of termination shall remain.
