

RESOLUTION 92 07 08 -262

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, establishing new water rates for District customers and repealing prior rate Resolution No. 91 03 13 - 242

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners has received notice of increased wholesale water rates from the Seattle Water Department scheduled to go into effect June 1, 1992.

WHEREAS, the District's staff and engineering consultants have studied the District's projected growth, expenses and revenue needs for the next five years, which studies have been reviewed by the Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that additional revenues must be generated from water service to the District's customers in order to maintain fiscal responsibility in the Districts operations; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, as follows:

SECTION ONE: WATER SERVICE CHARGES. Customers of Water District No. 125 shall be charged for water service as follows:

(a) SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL RATE: (meter size of not more than 1"; base rate of \$ 6.50 per month* plus the following consumption charge:

- (1) SUMMER (water used mid-May to mid-July and billed in July; water used mid-June to mid-August and billed in August; water used mid-July to mid-September and billed in September; water used mid-August to mid-October and billed in October):

(b) MULTIPLE RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL AND MUNICIPAL RATE:

(c) WHOLESALE RATES TO OTHER WATER DISTRICTS: Base rate as in subsection (b) based on meter size plus a consumption charge of 1.07 cents per hundred cubic feet of water transferred through the meter.

(d) Sewer Districts Drawing Water Directly from Hydrants: 1.07 cents per hundred cubic feet of water drawn plus \$10.00 per invoice covering such water consumption.

(e) Standby Fire Protection:

SECTION TWO. EFFECTIVE DATE OF RATES. The Rates set forth in Section one of this Resolution shall be effective with the July 1992 billing.

SECTION THREE. DEFINITIONS.

(a) "Single family residence" shall mean an owned residence designed or used for residential occupancy by a single residential unit. Provided, however, that condominium residences shall be billed as multiple residential customers.

(b) "Unit" shall mean a single family residential quarters, a separate commercial building, a trailer located on a residential lot and connected for domestic water service, and any individually rentable apartment, office, place of business, trailer court stall or mobile home lot.

SECTION FOUR: REPEALER. Upon the effective date of the new rates set forth in this resolution, the following rate resolutions are repealed:
