

RESOLUTION NO 93 01 12 -279

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington clarifying the ten percent penalty and funds received on customers bills and amending Resolutions 92 08 12 -264.

WHEREAS, STATE LAW (R.C.W.57.080.080) requires that the Commissioners enforce collection of charges for water supplied by addition of penalties of 10% of the charges due in case of failure to pay charges at times fixed by Resolution; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No 125 King County, Washington, as follows:


Resolution No 92 08 12 -264 is hereby amended to add the following:

SECTION FIVE. Penalty for Delinquent Bills.

Bills for water supplied shall be dated the 21st day of the month of the bill; and the bill shall become delinquent if ^{by} payment is not received in the office within thirty days of the date of the bill and a 10 percent penalty will be assessed 31 days thereafter on any unpaid balance. Penalties and all other charges will also be charged a 10% penalty thirty one days after they are assessed.

Payments received on account will be applied first to any previous balance owing and the balance of the funds will then be credited to the current bill.
