

RESOLUTION NO. 93 11 10-277

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington, providing for adjustments to the District's general facilities charges and amending Resolution No. 93 05 12-274

WHEREAS, on May 12, 1993 the District adopted a comprehensive new general facilities charge in compliance with R.C.W. 57.08.010(3); and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the commissioners that some owners of single family residential properties seeking to connect to the District's water distribution system may be required by a city government exercising jurisdiction over the property to install a connection of a size greater than necessary for water distribution in order to accommodate fire sprinkler requirements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125 as follows:

Resolution No. 93 05 12-274 is amended to add the following language:

Provided, however, that in the event the owner of a single family residential property is required by a city exercising jurisdiction over the property to install a connection of a size greater than necessary for ordinary water flow, for the purpose of fire sprinkling, the property owner will be charged for the connection size necessary only for ordinary flow, rather than the larger sizing.
