

RESOLUTION NO. 98 10 08-312

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, Washington consenting to the providing of water service in a specified area north and west of Seattle-Tacoma International Airport by Water District No. 20.

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle's "Third Runway Project" will result in loss of residences and abandonment of water lines in an area on the northwest limits of the current airport; and


WHEREAS, the continuing of service by Water District No. 125 in the area being abandoned due to the Third Runway Project will not be practical; and the only service, after completion of the Third Runway Project, in that area, will be fire hydrants serving a new road to be built by the Port of Seattle for the City of Sea-Tac; and

WHEREAS, Water District No. 20 is willing and able to serve such limited area from its water distribution system; NOW, THEREFORE:


BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County pursuant to RCW 57.08.044:

Upon abandonment of the current South 156th Street, South 156th Way and South 154th Street (all formerly known as part of "Renton-Three Tree Point Road") lying South of State Route 518 and replacement thereof by a new road to be built by the Port of Seattle for the City of Sea-Tac, Water District No. 125 consents to service of such new road south of SR 518 from the western boundary of Water District No. 125 to where such road crosses to the north of SR 518 by Water District No. 20.
